

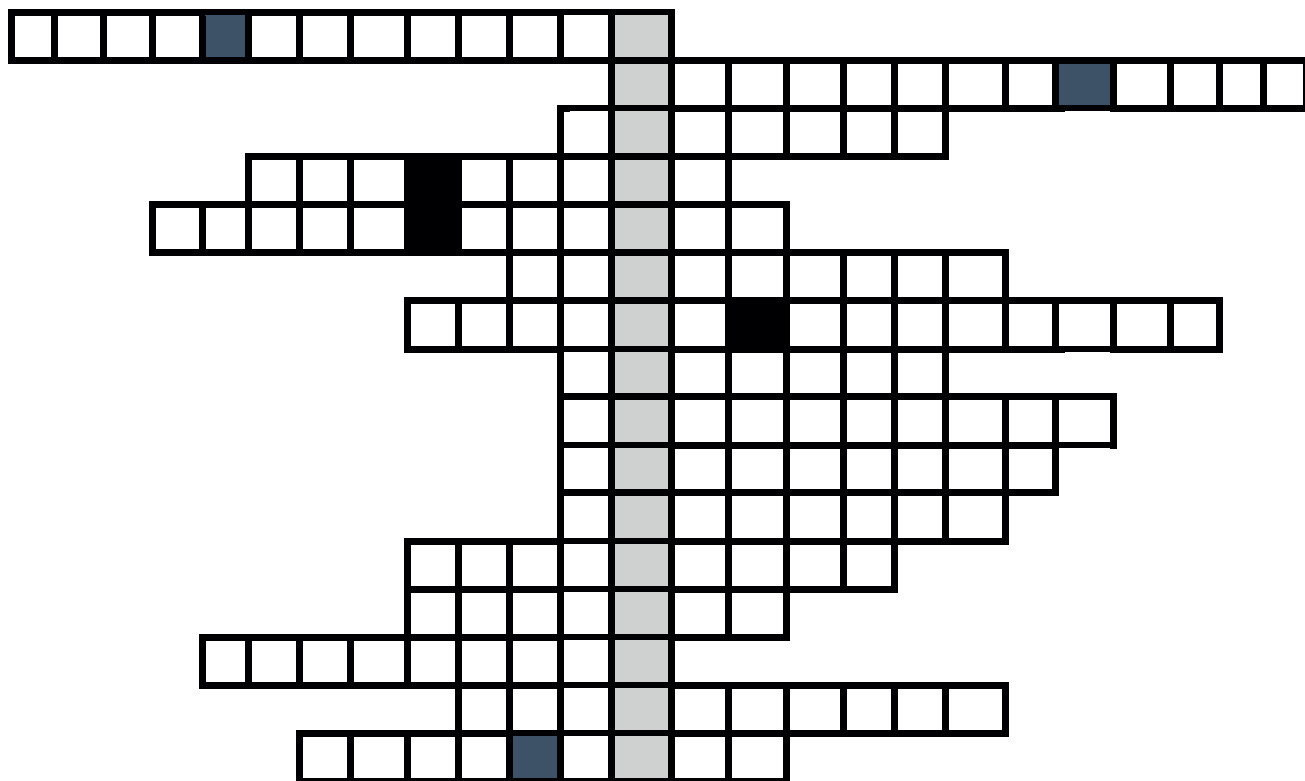


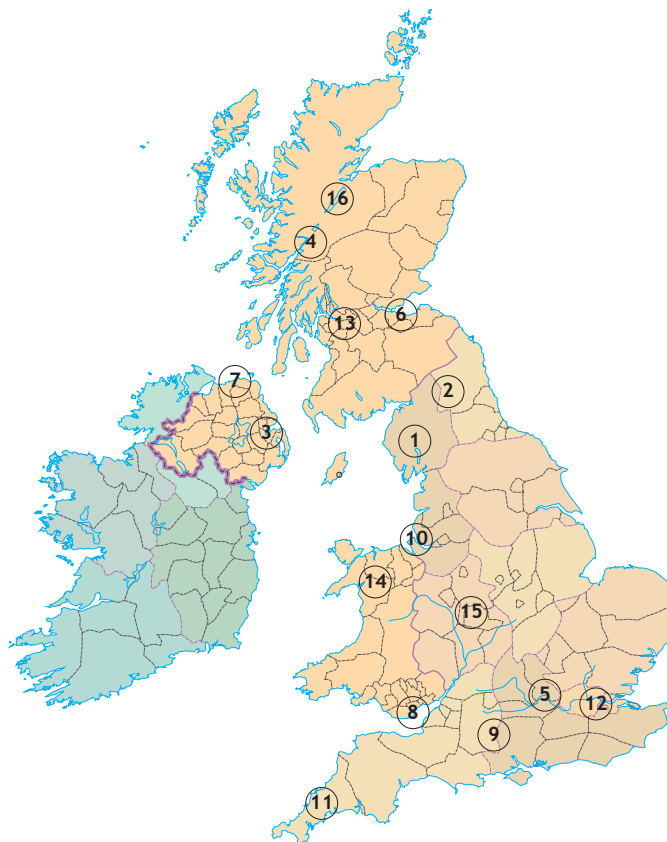
## BREAK THE ENIGMA CODE (WITH THE MAP OF THE UK)!
